



BNP Announces Five-Day Founding Anniversary Programme



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The Bangladesh Nationalist Party (BNP) has announced a five-day programme to mark its 48th founding anniversary. BNP Acting Secretary General Ruhul Kabir Rizvi Ahmed announced the programme while speaking to journalists ahead of the party's joint meeting at Nayapaltan in the capital on Wednesday (August 26).

He said that on the first day of the programme, September 1 at 9:00 am, BNP Chairman and Prime Minister Tarique Rahman will pay tribute at the graves of the party's founder Ziaur Rahman and former Prime Minister Khaleda Zia in Sher-e-Bangla Nagar.

In addition, senior leaders of the party will address a discussion meeting organised on September 5 to mark the founding anniversary.

Ruhul Kabir Rizvi said two more programmes would be held at a convenient time in September. At one of them, BNP Joint Secretary General Habib-un-Nabi Khan Sohel will release fish fry into an open water body. Another programme will feature a tree plantation drive led by Joint Secretary General Shahid Uddin Chowdhury Annie.

He said the party is also planning several other programmes to mark the founding anniversary. Drafts of those programmes will be finalised after discussions with the party chairman.

The joint meeting at Nayapaltan was attended by the party's joint secretaries general, as well as the conveners and member secretaries of the BNP's Dhaka North and South city units and the central presidents, conveners, general secretaries and member secretaries of its affiliated and associate organisations.
