



Dr. Shafiqur Rahman Re-elected Jamaat Chief

Dr. Shafiqur Rahman has been re-elected as the leader (Ameer) of Bangladesh Jamaat-e-Islami for the next three-year term (2026–2028).

On Saturday night (November 1), Jamaat's Chief Election Commissioner and Assistant Secretary General, Maulana ATM Masum, officially announced the election results. The organization confirmed the outcome through a press release issued on Sunday (November 2).

According to Jamaat, voting took place across the country from October 9 to October 25 through a secret ballot participated in by the party's Rukon (members). After the voting concluded, the designated committee completed the counting process and submitted the results to the Election Commission.

Based on the final results, Dr. Shafiqur Rahman received the highest number of votes and will serve as the Ameer of Bangladesh Jamaat-e-Islami for the next three years.
