



Suicide attack in Pakistan kills 8 soldiers

At least eight soldiers were killed in a deadly suicide bombing in Pakistan's northwestern Khyber Pakhtunkhwa province. Several others were also injured in the attack. The banned militant group Tehrik-i-Taliban Pakistan (TTP) has claimed responsibility.

According to reports from international media, the attack targeted a military gathering in Bajaur district, near the Afghanistan border. The area has long been considered a security risk due to ongoing militant activity.

Eyewitnesses said the attacker entered among the gathered soldiers and detonated explosives, killing at least eight soldiers on the spot and spreading panic in the surrounding area.

Following the attack, the TTP issued a statement claiming responsibility. However, the Pakistani government has not yet issued an immediate response. It also remains unclear whether a security operation has been launched in the area after the incident.
