The Facebook page of Inside the Haramine has also reported that the moon rises in Saudi Arabia. It is said that the moon of Ramadan was seen on Friday in the sky of Saudi Arabia. As a result, the month of Sha'ban is coming to an end. And the first day of Ramadan will be Saturday.

This year, Australia made the formal announcement of Ramadan in the world after seeing the moon. The same announcement came from Indonesia, the largest Muslim country. Although Indonesia's neighbor Brunei and Ramadan moon were not seen in Malaysia. Because of this, the holy Ramadan will start from March 2 in these two countries. Besides, the Philippines later reported that they did not see the moon here tonight. The moon of Ramadan was not seen in Pakistan.

On the other hand, the moon of Ramadan is seen in Tanzania, Ethiopia, the African country. France also announced the start of Ramadan from Saturday, that is Sunday start of Bangladesh Ramadan or Siam.
