



National Citizen Party Seeks 'Shapla Koli' as Election Symbol

The National Citizen Party (NCP) has expressed its interest in using the “Shapla Koli” (water lily bud) as its election symbol for the upcoming national polls. The party’s Chief Coordinator, Nasiruddin Patwary, stated that all official procedures have been completed, and they are now awaiting approval of the symbol.

Speaking to reporters on Sunday (November 2) after a meeting with the Election Commission (EC) at the commission’s headquarters in Agargaon, Dhaka, Patwary said,

“We have submitted all necessary documents as per EC regulations. Our party is fully prepared to take part in the election, and we hope that voters will see NCP represented by the ‘Shapla Koli’ symbol on the ballot.”

He further added that the NCP, as a people-oriented political organization, believes in fair and participatory elections. He expressed hope that obtaining the symbol would further strengthen the party’s organizational base.
