



13 Killed in Israeli Airstrikes in Lebanon

At least 13 people were killed in Israeli airstrikes in southern Lebanon, according to the Lebanese Health Ministry. The victims included a soldier, a child, and two rescue workers.

The strikes were carried out in several areas on Tuesday. In the city of Nabatieh, five people were killed in one attack. Another strike near the town of Zebqine left four people dead, including a Lebanese soldier and a Syrian national.

In the Bint Jbeil area, four more civilians, including a child and a woman, were killed in separate airstrikes. Rescue operations were launched in several affected locations following the attacks.

Despite the announcement of a ceasefire, tensions between Israel Defense Forces and Hezbollah remain high. Israel says its operations are targeting Hezbollah-linked sites and members.

Since renewed fighting began in March, continuous strikes have been reported across southern Lebanon. Local sources say Israeli forces are still present in several border areas.
