



Closing Arguments in Sheikh Hasina's War Crimes Case Begin Tomorrow

The closing arguments in the war crimes case against Sheikh Hasina and two others will begin tomorrow. The prosecution will present its arguments first, which will be broadcast live.

The closing arguments in the war crimes case against Sheikh Hasina and two others are set to begin tomorrow, Sunday. The case concerns incidents that allegedly occurred between July and August 2024.

On the first day, the prosecution will present its arguments. After that, the defense lawyers representing Sheikh Hasina will place their arguments before the tribunal. In the final stage, the prosecution will respond to the defense's statements. Once these hearings are completed, the case will move toward the verdict stage.

Prosecutor Gazi M. H. Tamim informed reporters that the prosecution's arguments will be broadcast live on the official Facebook page of the prosecution and on Bangladesh Television.

Earlier, on Wednesday, the cross-examination of the 54th and final witness, Investigation Officer Md. Alamgir, was completed. Following that, the International Crimes Tribunal-1, led by Justice Md. Golam Mortuza Mojumdar and comprising three members, scheduled Sunday as the date for the start of the closing arguments.
