



Araghchi Stresses Regional Security Cooperation

Iranian Foreign Minister has emphasized the importance of cooperation among regional countries to establish lasting security and stability in the Middle East, stating that no effective regional security framework can be built without Iran's participation.

Speaking at a meeting with social activists and public gathering organizers in Tehran on Sunday (June 14), Araghchi said recent developments have demonstrated that long-term peace and security can only be achieved through joint initiatives that respect the interests of all countries in the region.

He noted that Iran's position on the international stage is not based solely on its military capabilities. According to Araghchi, national unity, public resilience, and the active involvement of citizens during times of crisis are also key sources of the country's strength.

Referring to recent conflicts, the Iranian foreign minister claimed that Iran has achieved significant strategic successes by overcoming various pressures and challenges, adding that the impact of those achievements is beginning to be seen at both regional and international levels.

Araghchi further said that any future security system in the Middle East must include the participation of all countries in the region. He stressed that Iran has consistently supported a cooperative and inclusive approach to regional security.
