



Highest ODI Partnerships For Pakistan Vs South Africa



South Africa and Pakistan are competitive opponents who leave no stone unturned when it comes to playing against each other. These sides have a great history of playing high-profile matches where many records get broken.

In the recently concluded third ODI of the ongoing tri-series between these two sides happening in Pakistan, the hosts chased down a record total of 353 in 49 overs to beat South Africa and qualify for the finals of the tournament as they will next face New Zealand.

The game was more in favour of South Africa, and that's when skipper Mohammed Rizwan and Salman Agha joined their forces to squeeze the win out of South Africa's hands. This partnership proved to be extremely valuable as Pakistan went on to finish the game with six deliveries to spare. On the fifth position in this list features Imran Farhat and Misbah-ul-Haq's famous 153-run stand against South Africa in Durban during the year 2013 when they helped Pakistan chase down 235 successfully with three wickets to spare.
