



Vote Hijacking in Elections Will Not Be Tolerated: Jamaat Ameer

Jamaat-e-Islami Ameer Dr. Shafiqur Rahman said at an event in Mirpur, Dhaka on Tuesday (18 November) that any attempt to hijack votes in the election will not be acceptable under any circumstances.

He further stated that if Jamaat-e-Islami comes to power, extortion and terrorism will be completely eradicated from the country. A corruption-free administrative system will be established under the party's leadership. Education will be given top priority, and employment opportunities will be ensured after the completion of academic studies.
