



13th National Parliamentary Election to be Held in Early February Next Year: CEC

Chief Election Commissioner (CEC) A. M. M. Nasir Uddin has announced that the 13th National Parliamentary Election will be held in the first half of February next year. To ensure a free, fair, and credible election, law enforcement agencies will remain vigilant, and if any disorder occurs, the voting process may be suspended pending investigation.

Speaking to journalists on Saturday (August 9) at the Rangpur Divisional Commissioner's office, the CEC stated the election timeline and preparations.

He said, "There will be no tolerance for any disorderly conduct during the upcoming election. Law enforcement agencies will be on alert regarding this. However, if any undesirable incidents occur, necessary measures will be taken based on investigations, including suspension of voting if required."

He further added that the Election Commission is making all kinds of preparations to organize a free, fair, and credible election. Additionally, plans are underway regarding which organizations can be involved in the election process, and these details will be revealed in due course.
