



Trump Claims Israel's Survival Tied to His Intervention

U.S. President Donald Trump has said that his role was crucial in ensuring Israel's security and survival, claiming the country could have faced a severe crisis long ago if he had not taken active steps. The remarks were reported by The Telegraph.

Speaking during discussions with Qatar's Emir Sheikh Tamim bin Hamad Al Thani on the sidelines of the G7 summit, Trump said his administration took strong measures in support of Israel that other U.S. administrations were unwilling to pursue. He added that this is why he believes his involvement played a decisive role in Israel's position today.

Trump also addressed the situation in Lebanon, warning Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu that continued military escalation could undermine ongoing peace efforts.

Reflecting on Lebanon's past, Trump said the country was once known for its education system, professional expertise, and skilled workforce, but argued that it has since moved far from that status.

Earlier, Trump had also expressed dissatisfaction in a phone call with Netanyahu, questioning some of the Israeli leader's decisions.
