



National Mourning to Be Observed on July 16 Marking ‘July Martyrs’ Day’

The government has declared Wednesday, July 16, as a day of national mourning in observance of ‘July Martyrs’ Day’. A circular in this regard was issued on Tuesday by the Cabinet Division.

Signed by Cabinet Secretary Sheikh Abdur Rashid, the notice states that the national flag will be flown at half-mast across all government, semi-government, autonomous, and educational institutions, as well as on all public and private buildings throughout the country. Bangladesh missions abroad will also hoist the national flag at half-mast to honor the day.

Special prayers will be held at mosques across the country for the souls of the martyrs. Prayers and religious observances will also take place in temples, churches, and other places of worship seeking eternal peace for the departed.
