



Election Preparations Begin: Chief Adviser Sends Letter to EC for February Polls

The Office of the Chief Adviser has sent a letter to the Election Commission (EC) urging it to begin preparations for holding the national parliamentary elections in February 2026, ahead of the start of Ramadan.

To ensure the 2026 national parliamentary elections are held before the beginning of Ramadan in February, the Office of the Chief Adviser has formally requested the Election Commission to initiate necessary preparations. An official letter has been sent to the Chief Election Commissioner, formalizing the government's intent to facilitate the electoral process.

On Wednesday (August 6), the matter was confirmed by Shafiqul Alam, Press Secretary to the Chief Adviser. He stated that the letter, signed by Cabinet Secretary M. Siraj Uddin Mia, called upon the Election Commission to begin all necessary steps to conduct the election in a "free, fair, peaceful, and festive atmosphere."
