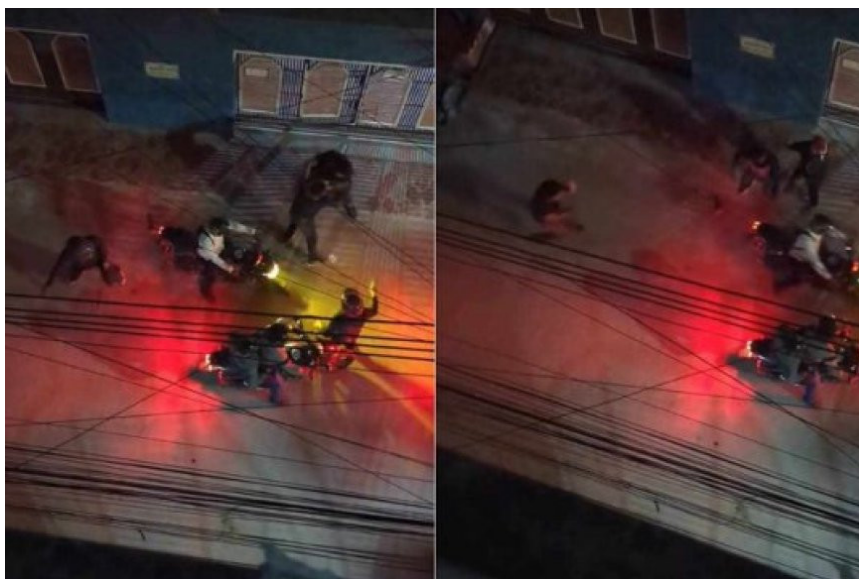




Banasree shot the trader in the '25 -wheel' gold robbery

Anwar Hossain (1), a gold trader named Anwar Hossain (1) in the capital's Banasree area, has taken away the '25 gold and Tk 1 lakh in cash'. The incident took place on

The injured businessman was rescued and admitted to Dhaka Medical College Hospital. He is now undergoing treatment.

Rampura Police Station Officer -in -Charge Mohammad Ataur Rahman Akand said this at night. He said that there is a jewelry shop in Banasree, a gold trader Anwar Hossain. He closed the shop and returned home alone. On the way, the miscreants on the three motorcycles stopped Anwar Hossain. A man wearing a red helmet from them opened fire to the businessman three rounds. He said the victim Anwar Hossain had two legs on his two legs and one on his back. He was rescued and admitted to Dhaka Medical (DMC) College Hospital.

According to the injured businessman, the OC also said that he had 25 gold and Tk 1 lakh in cash. After the shootings, the miscreants took gold and money. Locals said that three motorcycles, which were targeted at the number 7 road in the D block of Banasree, were stopped at around 7:30 pm. The three motorcycles then pulled the gold traders to pick up the gold. At one point they did not want to give gold, they shot the businessman. Then the robbers got up on three motorcycles with gold and money and left the area.

A resident of a nearby building made a video. In the meantime, the video has spread on social media. In that 5 -second video, there were seven motorcycles in a total of seven. The helmet was on everyone's head. Gold businessman At one point with the gold trader Anwar, one of the red helmets shot him with a pistol. Then all three motorcycles are all gone together
