



Sushant's Family to Take New Legal Action Over Death Investigation

The family of Bollywood actor Sushant Singh Rajput has expressed dissatisfaction with the CBI's closure report on his death investigation. They have announced plans to challenge the report in court soon.

On June 14, 2020, Sushant was found dead at his residence in Bandra, Mumbai. Initially, police labeled the incident as suicide. However, following public pressure and the family's allegations, the investigation was later handed over to the Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI).

Recently, the CBI submitted its closure report, stating that there was no evidence of abetment to suicide or any other criminal offense in Sushant's death. The agency also gave a clean chit to the actor's girlfriend, Rhea Chakraborty.

However, Sushant's family has strongly objected to this decision, claiming the investigation was incomplete and that the CBI concealed crucial information. A family member said, "If the investigation had truly been impartial, all related documents would have been made public along with the report."

Since Sushant's death, the family has consistently accused Rhea Chakraborty of mental harassment and abetment to suicide. Although Rhea was arrested following the incident, she was later released on bail.

Now, the family is preparing for a renewed legal battle. Their lawyer has confirmed that they will challenge the CBI's findings in court and demand a fresh, transparent investigation to uncover the truth.
