



EC to begin dialogue with parties from 13 November

The Election Commission (EC) is set to start formal dialogue with political parties from November 13. The EC's Public Relations Division confirmed this information in a notice on Sunday (November 9).

According to the EC's initial plan, representatives from six political parties will participate in each session. Two sessions will be held per day, meaning a total of 12 parties will be engaged daily. It is reported that, in the final stage of the dialogue, BNP and Jamaat-e-Islami will be invited.

Earlier, the Election Commission held multiple rounds of discussions with representatives of the teaching community, election experts, and civil society members.

EC sources also stated that the commission may make a policy decision not to invite any parties from the 14-party alliance, including the National Party, JASAD, Ganatantri Party, Zaker Party, Tariqat Federation, Socialist Party, and NAP, to this dialogue.
