



Saudi Arabia Condemns Iranian Attacks on Jordan

Saudi Arabia has strongly condemned Iran's ongoing attacks on Jordan. The Saudi Foreign Ministry expressed its position in a statement issued on Wednesday, September 9.

The statement said Iran's bombing attacks constitute a direct violation of international law and the principles of good-neighborly relations. Saudi Arabia called for an immediate end to such attacks against Jordan and other countries in the Middle East.

It also urged effective and serious measures to restore security and stability across the region.

Earlier, Iran's Islamic Revolutionary Guard Corps (IRGC) said it had launched a ballistic missile attack targeting a US military base in Jordan. The United States, however, said there were no casualties in the attack.

The IRGC said its retaliatory attacks would continue until US aggression comes to an end.
