



## Whether the girls smoke are illegal, anger-protests in the Home Advisor's comment



There has been widespread reaction to the physically assaulting two women over smoking at a tea shop in Lalmatia, Dhaka, the capital of Bangladesh. Many have expressed their anger; There has been protest. Home advisors' comments surrounding the incident have increased people's anger and criticism

Is it illegal to smoke girls? Home Advisor Md. Jahangir Alam Chowdhury commented, "Sake cigarettes in the open (open) place is forbidden for men and women." Many have also raised the question of whether the Home Advisor to Home Advisor is against the crime or the crime by making such a statement. A group of protesters protested at the banner 'Bangladesh against rape and persecution' on Monday and the protests were burnt by the home adviser. Besides, the Home Advisor's comments are strongly criticized by social media. Later, the police got the news and rescued them and took them to Mohammadpur police station. One of the young women described the entire incident on Facebook, but later he deactivated his account. He described their beating and abusing in the post. And wrote that smoking in public space in public space in public space in Bangladesh is a punishable offense in Bangladesh. Through this, smoke has been stopped publicly in public transport, big shopping malls and government office courts.

Police have claimed that there was a negotiation between the two parties after the debate for several hours. Later two women were released in the family custody
